

KPM April 2024 Footpath Warden Update (Phil Beeston)

1) Nearly all paths have dried out over the last couple of weeks and are generally in a lot better condition, though I have not walked many of the field paths yet. The path by the Cricket Club on Camp Lane is no better, with flowing water in the field entrance.

2) I tried to log the condition of the path by the river (by the bridge on Beech Lane) and that path is not notifiable through Fix My Street, I assume it is a permissive path (like the Pocket Park) and is part of the Country Park. I could not find a way to notify them, can I asked the Parish Clerk (when appointed) to follow up please. Notes and pictures below.

Over the first 250 yards of the path by the river, that starts just past the bridge on Beech Lane, the path surface has been washed away leaving exposed blocks with holes in them, making it a difficult surface to walk on, can this be repaired, it will not improve and will at somepoint likely cause an injury to a person or a dog.
